Stipulations:

- 1. The scholarship provided by the university will cover \$1,000 of tuition each semester for four semesters (scholarship not awarded during the summer semester).
2. The applicant agrees to conduct four evening field experience sessions (approximately one per month) in collaboration with the Graduate programs in the Lipscomb College of Education during each of the four semesters receiving this scholarship.
3. If a student must leave full-time employment with the school for any reason, the student will no longer qualify for the scholarship.
4. The applicant agrees to notify the Lipscomb College of Education of any change in his/her employment status.

3. Summative Teaching Evaluation report from previous year with Teacher Effectiveness Score
4. Recommendation form completed by current administrator
5. Essay describing why your classroom is a great place for future teachers to learn, what attributes you possess that make you a positive coach for future teachers, and what you think today's teachers need to know before beginning teaching. Also include details about your flexibility in offering these sessions after school hours.
6. Selected candidates will coordinate time for a Lipscomb faculty member to visit for a classroom observation in the final stage of selection.
