Day 1: 04 October 2025

Arrive Boston, MA (3 nights)

Upon arrival in Boston, there is one group pick up from the airport. Today you'll visit the USS Constitution, the world's oldest commissioned warship afloat and America's Ship of State*. This evening enjoy a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant.

*Flights must arrive no later than 1pm to accommodate the USS Constitution visit.

Day 2: 05 October 2025

Concord

This morning visit Author's Ridge in the Sleepy Hollow Cemetery to pay homage to the graves of famous authors including Louisa May Alcott, Ralph Waldo Emerson, Nathaniel Hawthorne, and Henry David Thoreau. Then, explore Concord Bridge, a pivotal site in American history where the first shots of the Revolutionary War were fired. Explore the Old Manse, a historic home once inhabited by Ralph Waldo Emerson and Nathaniel Hawthorne. It's a place rich in literary and historical significance. Visit the Louisa May Alcott House, where the beloved author of "Little Women" lived and wrote. Take a guided tour of the Ralph Waldo Emerson House, where the transcendentalist thinker lived and worked.

Day 3: 06 October 2025

Boston

This morning enjoy a city tour with your Travel Director, pointing out key landmarks such as the Freedom Trail and Boston Common. For lunch you are free to grab a bite at Quincy Market in downtown Boston. Visit the oldest building in downtown Boston and the home of Paul Revere and his family during the time of the Revolution. Afterward, head to Cambridge to visit the Longfellow House, the former home of the renowned poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. Enjoy an included dinner at a local restaurant this evening.

Day 4: 07 October 2025

Stockbridge (1 night)

Vsit the Old North Church in Boston's North End, the first stop on Paul Revere's "Midnight Ride," and known for its famous "one if by land, two if by sea" signal. Vist the former home of Edith Wharton, The Mount. Take a guided tour of the elegant estate and explore the beautiful gardens that inspired Wharton's writing. Then continue your journey to Stockbridge, Massachusetts to explore the Norman Rockwell Museum, which showcases the works of the iconic American illustrator. Admire Rockwell's nostalgic depictions of American life and browse the museum's extensive collection.

Day 5: 08 October 2025

Hartford (1 night)

Today visit the Herman Melville Arrowhead Museum in nearby Pittsfield. Explore the home where Herman Melville wrote his iconic novel "Moby-Dick" and learn about the author's life and work. Continue your literary journey with a visit to the Emily Dickinson Museum in Amherst, Massachusetts to learn about the life and poetry of one of America's most celebrated poets. Next enjoy a guided tour of the former home of Samuel Clemens, better known as Mark Twain, and learn about the author's life and works. Enjoy dinner tonight at a local restaurant.

Day 6: 09 October 2025

Boston (1 night)

Visit the Stowe Center for Literary Activism, and former home of Harriet Beecher Stowe, author of "Uncle Tom's Cabin", and learn about her influential role in the abolitionist movement. Next head to Salem to tour the House of the Seven Gables, a historic mansion made famous by Nathaniel Hawthorne's novel. This evening return to Boston for your Farewell Dinner and last night.
