

AI Tool Use with Research

When AI tools are proposed for use in Lipscomb-authorized research, all tools require a risk assessment to be conducted by Information Technology's Cybersecurity team, and the office of General Counsel must approve any Terms of Service and Privacy policies for the tool.

When preparing your proposal for the IRB, please be aware of the following policy and guidelines for the use of AI at Lipscomb. (Lipscomb logon will be required to access these documents)

Process Overview:

Step 1: Check if your proposed AI tool is on the pre-approved list below. Note: You must be using a Lipscomb-provided account for each tool for it to be approved.

Step 2: If your tool is listed, proceed with your IRB proposal.

Step 3: If it is not listed, complete the following a minimum of two business weeks prior to needing a decision:

- Submit the [AI Tool Use Request Form](#) using your Lipscomb account. The Lipscomb Cybersecurity team will conduct a risk assessment of the tool and the proposed use case and notify you if a contract approval form is required. You will receive an email notification with a summary of the risk assessment's findings and the cybersecurity team's recommendations for leadership approval.
